What This Book Will Do for You

Keep Human Analysis at the Center

The nonfiction writer's most valuable work often happens after the facts have been collected.

Ask What the Evidence Actually Supports

Separate what is known, what is strongly suggested, what is possible, and what is merely interesting.

Do not strengthen language simply because a cleaner conclusion would make the chapter easier to write.

Look for Alternative Explanations

Before settling on a conclusion, ask what else could explain the same evidence. This is especially important with data, trends, personal testimony, and stories selected from a larger population.

Name the Limits

Readers trust writers who explain the boundaries of a claim. A limitation is not automatically a weakness; it is often evidence that the writer understands the material.

Writer's Edge Check-In

- What conclusion are you most tempted to overstate?
- What alternative explanation deserves consideration?
- What limitation should the reader know?

Revise for Fairness, Not False Balance

Fair nonfiction is not the same as giving every claim equal weight.

Represent Serious Counterevidence

If credible evidence challenges your conclusion, address it rather than hiding it.

Strong argument becomes stronger when the reader sees that the writer understands the best opposing evidence.

Do Not Manufacture Equivalence

A fringe claim does not automatically deserve equal space with well-supported evidence.

Weight competing claims according to credibility, relevance, and evidence.

Check Who Is Missing

Ask whose experience, expertise, or consequence is absent from the manuscript.

Missing perspectives can create distortion even when every individual fact is correct.

- Are you confusing fairness with equal weight?
- Whose perspective is missing?
